- Step One: 1st to 93th measure inclusive (measure numbers are shown in figures in the boxes).
- Step Two: transition to the 1st measure and from the 1st measure to the 24nd measure inclusive.
- Step Three: transition to the 94th measure and from the 94th measure until the end.

Let me also remind you that according to the rules of notation, the measure numbers are shown in the beginning of the measures.
